Next weekend, September 6th & 7th, Fr. Jeff will be speaking at each Liturgy to explain our campaign and ask all parishioners to consider donating a total of 10-15 hours during the months of September and October to this important project. Volunteers are needed for visiting, making phone calls, preparing mailings and helping at receptions. The more people we have involved, the easier our task will be!
