OVER \$181,000 PLEGGED!

To date, we have received pledges & gifts totaling \$181,500. This puts us at 18% of our goal from 14 families. We are very grateful to all those who have contributed to the Campaign, and we thank you for your generosity. However, in order to reach our goal, we need every family to participate. Please join us in giving back to God by making a pledge to the best of your financial ability. Let's keep this momentum going.

Even if you have not RSVP'd, you and your family are more than welcome to attend a reception.
