Father Jeff led the discussion for this meeting. We discussed the differences between a parish vs. pastoral council and the model for Christ the King's pastoral council.

The consensus was that Christ the King's Pastoral council will be a Visionary as well as an Advisory body. The council empowers the other parish ministries to help fulfill the plan. The council also provides support to the parish "team".

New Business:

The pastor's residence needs significant repair. In order to meet building codes, the plumbing, electrical and heating needs to be updated. The kitchen and bathroom will also be updated and an egress window will be built for the basement. These repairs are estimated to cost approximately \$55,000.00. Jeff Wilson Construction will do the work. The Council unanimously approved this proposal.

Bishop Thomas will officially install Fr Jeff Fleming as out Pastor on Saturday, October 28, 2006 at the 5:15 Mass. All were invited to participate in this liturgy.

Results of the parish surveys were distributed to all pastoral council members prior to this meeting. Based on the data from these questions, we will choose a goal and begin to plan objectives at the November meeting.

Representatives from the UM students group were invited to join the pastoral council. Amber stated that one campus intern would be present at each meeting and Jimmy Woolyhound will join the council as a student representative.
