MINUTES

We opened by saying the Embracing our Mission Prayer together

Father Jeff showed us photos and we did a quick tour of the damage done from an apparent frozen pipe in the 'penthouse' where the fire suppression equipment is housed. The insurance company has sent an appraiser and the Diocese was notified. Remedies and repairs have been done and more planned. The insurance policy has a \$500 deductible.

Linda provided us with Profit & Loss statements to date. There were no unusual or concerning expenses noted.

Father Jeff gave us an update on the Capital Campaign. To date 258 of 750 families have made pledges totaling just over \$700,000. Follow-up phase of the campaign has begun, but due to very few volunteers, little has been accomplished. A payment was made to the Diocese in December for \$29,687. Pledge commitments have been arriving regularly. The follow up committee will continue to meet and work toward contacting those families who have not responded to the request.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
