MINUTES

We opened by saying the Embracing our Mission Prayer together

Linda provided us with Profit & Loss statements to date. There were no unusual or concerning expenses noted. Offertory is short approximately \$9,000 from budget.

Father Jeff gave us an update on the Capital Campaign. To date 200 families of 750 have made pledges totaling just over \$600,000. Follow-up phase of the campaign has begun with letters and home visits to families who have not pledged. There was discussion of how the pledged amounts are apportioned by the Diocese and how and when payments will be required. Father Jeff will ask the Diocese. It was noted that we owe Guidance in Giving \$14,000.

Father Jeff presented a financial statement for the past year and the budget for the current year in a form that is easy to read and understand. This will be mailed to each household in the parish. Some minor changes were suggested.

Al Pontrelli and John Tabaracci volunteered to research the different Finance Council by-laws that Father Jeff has procured and present a proposed set of by laws for Christ the King Finance Council.

Western Business Equipment presented a bid on a new copier as the existing copier is on its last breath. Father Jeff will check with Office Solutions to see if they have a competitive priced unit. If not, we agreed he should purchase the one presented. Funds from the money market account will be used for this purchase.
