FINANCE COUNCIL MEETING
Sept 18, 2008
MINUTES

Father Jeff opened with a prayer.

Sue & Linda provided lunch.

The council welcomed John Tabaracci, a new member of the Finance Council and said goodbye and thanks to David Rehbein who stepped down after several years of service.

Linda provided us with Profit & Loss statements to date. Our offertory is approximately \$12,000 below budget and expenses are slightly below budget. There were no unusual or concerning expenses noted.

Sue asked that we begin a process to determine the amount to charge for the use of the church facility. We agreed to charge the Crosio group \$600 for their retreat in January.

Father Jeff and Laura Hunter with Guidance in Giving reported on the progress of the Capital Campaign. As of Sunday September 21st, 14 families have pledged \$200,000. Sunday September 28th is the official pledge date when families are asked to have their pledges into the parish. As of Sunday, all receptions have been held and the turnout has been very encouraging. A note was made that Sheila Miller who works for Catholic Printery and is a member of Christ the King, convinced Catholic Printery to donate the printing of our Capital Campaign brochure, which was a great savings for the parish. Please thank Sheila when you see her.

Father Jeff reported that the office purchased a software program and computer which were necessities in order to track the pledges and gifts for the capital campaign. This will also give us data base software for parish membership and parish offertory which will be extremely helpful as the parish grows and changes. On nearly the same day as the purchase, a special gift arrived at the parish which covered the cost of this purchase, truly an answer to prayers.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
